EXAMS

I. DRAWING EXAM for ALL DEPARTMENTS (Except THEATRE)

Date and Time: **10 August 2026, 10:00-12:00** [Candidates will take the exam at the date and time specified on the Exam Entrance Card.]

Location: Faculty of Art and Design Building, 4th Floor Main Entrance (Ring Stop No. 8)

Required Documents and Materials: [The choice of material types and quality belongs to the candidate]

- 35x50 cm Art Paper (4 pcs)
- 35x50 cm Duralite Base
- Clamp or Clip (for fastening paper to duralite)
- Soft Pencil
- Soft Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener

About the Exam: An object determined by the jury that day will be placed in front of the candidates. Candidates will be asked to draw the object that is placed to the hall, from the angle they see and to create a composition by adding an imaginary second object or subject. During the given exam period, the candidates' ability to draw what they see, design and arrange different objects on a surface is evaluated.

II. DRAWING EXAMS and PORTFOLIO EVALUATIONS for ALL DEPARTMENTS

- Candidates can choose **only one** program considering their interests and abilities.
- **There is no drawing exam for the Theater program.**
- Information about the **day and time of the portfolio evaluation** of the candidates **will be announced during the drawing exam.**

Candidates are required to bring all kinds of coloring materials, various drawing pens, at least 5 pieces of 35x50 cm drawing paper and any equipment they deem necessary for colorful illustration. ----- Candidates who will be included in the portfolio evaluation in the order of the candidate number, must have at least 5, at most 15, drawings, illustrations, designs, products, photographs etc., showing their interests and abilities in the field of textile and fashion design. They are required to bring their portfolio of the work with them. All works produced in digital media must be printed out. Works shown on telephones, tablets etc. are not going to be considered. The list indicating which candidate will undergo portfolio evaluation, along with the specific day and time slot, will be posted on the relevant notice boards on August 10 or 11, 2026; verbal notification will also be provided during the program's drawing exam.

Tirades and poems are required to be from a published book. Candidates are required to comply with the conditions set out in the information text sent to their e-mail addresses and to fill out the form. An interview will then be held to get to know the candidate.
